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If You Ask Me:



- easy to compute given a discrete mesh
- separating topology from geometry
 helps narrowing down where accuracy is lost
- conservation laws can be preserved exactly

preserving structures at the discrete level!

- > applicable to a variety of problems
- > good foundations for further studies
- can be used as basis for 'simplex sampling'

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Other Related Research Areas

Variational Integrators

- principle of *least-action* is crucial
- motion is a geodesic if we use action as "metric"
 - > preserve invariants and symmetries
- "not accurate?": urban legend, simply untrue
- Discrete Differential Euclidean Geometry
 - it all ties up through the use of connections
 - but it will be for another day...
